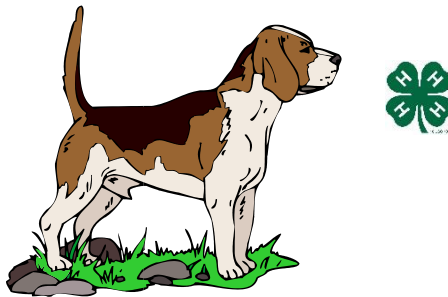


## DIVISION 30: DOG

### GENERAL RULES

1. Youth participant must be enrolled in the Dog Project Area on 4HOnline by January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.
2. Dogs must be owned and cared for to the fullest extent by youth exhibitor
3. Dogs must be at least 4 months of age by June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017
4. Dog Show Dress Code: Exhibitors must wear dark slacks or skirt and white shirt or club shirt.
5. All dogs must be entered into the obedience class for the current year's work, regardless of years in the club.
6. Dogs must be kept on lead at all times and only allowed to enter or exit fairground via midway.
7. 4-H dogs are only allowed in the 4-H tent area.
8. Exhibitors are responsible for their dog at all times. **ALL CLEAN-UP** and proper disposal of waste.
9. Exhibitors not obeying the rules will be disqualified by show committee.
10. Exhibitor and dogs must attend at least two 4-H training sessions at the 4-H Building directed by the D.O.G. 4-H Club between April 1<sup>st</sup> and June 1<sup>st</sup>.
11. Best in Show dog is chosen from the best performers in each class. Dogs entered in Beginner Obedience will not be eligible for Best in Show.
12. Seeing Eye Puppies will be judged on Grooming, Condition, & Handling.
13. Age of Seeing Eye Puppy is determined as of July 1<sup>st</sup>.
14. Age appropriate shot are required for all dogs to exhibit at the fair.  
Required shots: Rabies and DHLPP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis, Parvo, Parainfluenza)
15. Dog Care exhibitors may enter classes in DOG OR SEEING EYE PROJECT



# DOG SHOWS

## SHOW: DOG CARE AND TRAINING

### Classes

1. Grooming and Conditioning – Long Haired Dog
2. Grooming and Conditioning – Short Haired Dog
3. Show Handling - Non-experienced – 1<sup>st</sup> year or 4 or less shows or matches
4. Show Handling - Experienced – More than 4 shows or matches

### Obedience

5. Beginner
6. Pre-Novice A: Dog or exhibitor in 4 or less shows or matches. All work done on lead.
7. Pre-Novice B: Dog or exhibitor in more than 4 shows or matches. All work done on lead.
8. Intermediate Novice: Heel and Figure 8 on lead. Stand, Recall, Sit and Down off lead.
9. Novice - Dog has no legs toward CD.
10. Novice - Dog may have up to 2 legs toward CD.
11. Judging - Members will judge a dog doing the individual exercises of an AKC Novice Obedience routine.
