

DIVISION 33: LIVESTOCK

DIVISION 33 RULES

1. All livestock must be fitted for exhibition prior to arrival at the fair. Adult fitting is prohibited.
2. All livestock must arrive on Wednesday, July 12, 2017 between 12:00 and 5:00PM. The back gate, which allows admittance to the back of the tents, will be locked at 4:00PM on that day. Animals and equipment must be walked to designated areas, unless you have a car pass.
3. Uniforms for the show will be clean white shirt or blouse, and clean white pants or trousers. Members not properly attired will be unable to show.
4. All 4-H members showing livestock must participate in the showmanship class for their animal(s)
5. All animals, other than bottle fed babies between the ages of birth to three months, must remain on exhibit until 5:00PM on Sunday. Bottle fed babies may be brought in on the morning of the show and removed immediately after the show concludes.
6. A certificate of veterinary inspection dated within thirty (30) days of the show must be presented at the time of check-in with the animals. The certificate should indicate that the animals did not originate from a herd with foot rot, sore mouth, abscesses, coccidiosis or any other infectious or contagious disease.
7. Animals are subject to a health inspection upon entering the tent. Any animal determined to be unfit for the fair will be denied admittance and therefore not allowed to participate in the fair itself. Any animal becoming ill during the fair shall, at the recommendation of the tent superintendent, be removed by the owner, without forfeiture of premiums or awards previously earned.
8. Members must provide their own feed buckets, water pails, hay and grain. Be sure all of your personal items are labeled with your family name.
9. All pens must be cleaned daily, before the fair opens and maintained throughout the fair. All waste must be placed in a designated area. All members are responsible for the stripping of their own pens at the close of the fair on Sunday.
10. All animals must be disbudded or dehorned, unless appropriate for breed. Tent superintendent approval must be given for budded or horned animals.

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| A. Cloverbud Showmanship – | Grades K – 3 (Participation Award only) |

CLASSES – Classes will be for the following breeds: Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Toggenburg, and Recorded Grades

1. 0 – 4 months Junior Doe Kid
2. 4 – 8 months Junior Doe Kid
3. 8 – 12 months Junior Doe Kid
4. 12 – 24 months Dry Yearling
5. Junior Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion
6. Best Doe in Show
7. Milkers, 2 years
8. Milkers, 2 years and under 3 years
9. Milkers, 3 years and under 5 years
10. Milkers, 5 years and over
11. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion
12. Best Doe in Show
13. Dam and Daughter – do not have to be owned by one person. They may be entered separately and ownership indicated.
14. Miss Ocean County – a doe in milk, born to exhibitor, owned, raised, bred and continuously owned by exhibitor.

NOTE: Member needs to be registered in the Dairy Goat project area and be the owner of the goat for a minimum of 2 years to qualify for this award. This award is given to the member who exhibits not only a qualifying doe, but also the dedication and persistence needed to stay with the project.

ALL OTHER BREEDS:

Classes 15 – 19 will be judged individually if there are more than two entries per class. Wethers will be judged as market animals. Rosettes and prizes will be given to Grand Champions and Reserve Champions and Best Doe in Show.

33 – B: LIVESTOCK FUN SHOW RULES

1. Same show guidelines will apply
2. Show will be on Sunday following Dog Fun Show.
3. Registration for the Fun Show will be at the fair.
4. Classes may be altered to fit participating species.

ALL OTHER SPECIES

1. All livestock rules apply
2. Showmanship – To be judged on the ability of the showman to control and present the animal to its best advantage.
3. Fitting – To be judged on the cleanliness, grooming and clipping of the animal
4. Breed Classes – Will be determined at the show.
5. No one other than a 4-H club member may help in the fitting and showing of an animal at the fair. (Leaders may only help as an advisor). All animals shown in the showmanship and fitting classes must be owned or leased by the 4-H'er exhibiting it.
6. Each animal will be haltered with a strong rope halter or full face halter. Animals will be led with a proper halter. The Division Chairperson reserves the right to exclude unmanageable animals. Nervous animals requiring supervision will be the responsibility of the exhibitor and will require the exhibitor's constant attendance during the hours the fair is open to the public.
7. All classes may be divided into Junior or Senior depending on the number of entries.
8. Rail Judging – Exhibitors must have tied their cows/calves to the fence. All calves must have a number taped to their rump. 4-H members and leaders may vote on their placement according to their attributes. A judge will later give their opinion of the class placement.
