The Atlantic Sturgeon is a large long-lived fish that is currently federally protected under the Endangered Species Act. Having once supported a major commercial fishery throughout its historic range with peak landing in the late 1800's, populations had collapsed and continue to remain at historic lows over the last century. This pre-historic anadromous fish species has a complex life history and utilizes river, estuarine, coastal, and oceanic environments at different life-stages, while spending a majority of its life in saltwater undergoing large seasonal coastal migrations. 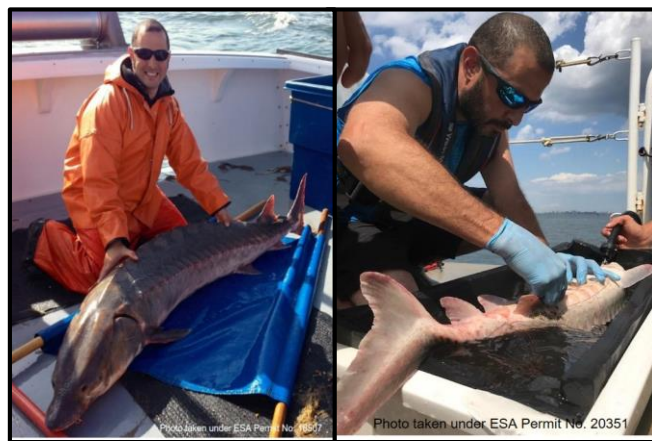
