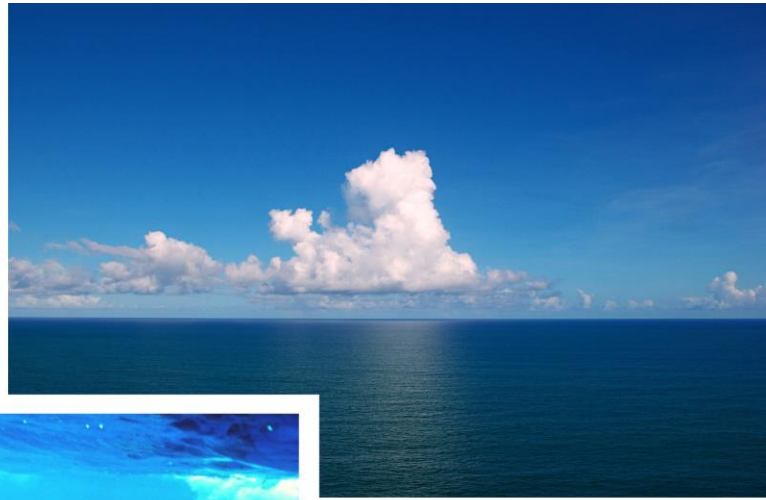


The Elements of Natural Resource Management
