Trumpet Honeysuckle

Lonicera sempervirens

Trumpet honeysuckle is a native alternative to invasive Japanese honeysuckle. (*L. japonica*) Trumpet honeysuckle doesn't have the scent we associate with summer, but it supports native bees, butterflies and moths, provides nectar for hummingbirds, and berries for other birds.

- Full sun to light shade
- Blooms late spring - early summer
- Can climb 8 - 15'
- Well-drained soil
- Host to the butterfly, Spring Azure and the moth, Snowberry Clearwing
